Chief Security Officer (CSO)



1 Definition

The Chief Security Officer must be a member of the entity's board of directors (or similar governing body), executive personnel, general partner, or senior management official with the ability to implement policy and direct resources. They must be able to obtain and maintain a Baseline security clearance.
